

Governance of the VFW License Plates

January 3, 2007

1. The following is the governance for the control of the Department of Motor Vehicle Special License Plate for the Veterans of Foreign Wars.
2. Reference is Delaware Title 21, Section 2140.
3. License Plates will be issued to only “Life Members” of the Department of Delaware, Veterans of Foreign Wars. The term “Life Member” is explained in Article 1, Section 111 National By-laws and Manual of Procedure.
4. The completed application, along with the application fee, must be sent to the VFW License Plate representative for verification of “Life Membership” in the Department of Delaware Veterans of Foreign Wars. The VFW representative is the **ONLY** authorized person that will sign all application forms (MV613) and process them through the DMV.
5. If a Life Member is found ineligible for membership in the Veterans of Foreign Wars, the member will be notified in writing to surrender the tag immediately to the nearest DMV. The VFW representative will also notify the DMV on the ineligible status of the former VFW Member.
6. Upon the death of a Life Member that holds a current VFW License Plate, DMV will notify the spouse that the VFW License Plate number will no longer be assigned to the vehicle upon the notification of death of the VFW Life Member to DMV.
7. Vehicle(s) must be registered and titled in the Life Members name to be eligible for the License Plate. Vehicle(s) registered/titled in a spouse/family member name of the Life Member are not eligible.

The fee of \$10.00 must accompany this application. This is a one-time charge only. However, you must still continue to have your vehicle inspected and pay your registration fee as required.

Applicants may apply for one (1) plate per vehicle. Upon receipt of notice that the individual is no longer affiliated with the organization for which the specialty plate has been issued, the plate must be returned to the Division of Motor Vehicles within 90 days per Title 21, Section 2139B.

Plates may be issued only on cars, station wagons, or trucks with not more than three-fourth ton maximum gross weight (10,000 gross vehicle weight).
